SUEZ Energy Resources Signs Contract with City of Dallas 40% of the Supply Will Be Based on Green Energy

HOUSTON, TX – September 26, 2007 – SUEZ Energy Resources NA, the U.S. retail energy business of SUEZ Energy North America, announced today that the City of Dallas has chosen SUEZ Energy Resources to provide approximately 90% of the City's electricity for municipal needs through 2008. Nearly half of the City's supply from SUEZ Energy Resources will be sourced from renewable energy.

SUEZ Energy Resources, the successful bidder in the City's competitive proposals process will provide electricity service to more than 1,900 accounts estimating a peak demand of nearly 150 MW in the Oncor territory. These accounts primarily supply energy to the City's largest usage loads such as office buildings, the convention center, and water utilities, as well as the city's non-demand meters, which include all street and traffic lights.

"We selected SUEZ Energy Resources to supply the City of Dallas' energy needs and meet our environmental initiatives because the company's pricing provides the best combination of cost and service for the citizens of Dallas," said Jesse Dillard, Energy Manager for the City of Dallas. "What's more, of all the companies we considered, SUEZ Energy Resources was the most responsive."

In addition, SUEZ was able to provide the City of Dallas with renewable electricity or "green" energy, which was a critical component to it when looking to enter into an agreement tailored to fit its needs. SUEZ Energy Resource's contract with the City of Dallas further expands the company's portfolio of green customers. "We are very pleased to partner with the City of Dallas by supporting its environmental efforts to improve overall quality of life for Dallas citizens," said Michel Sirat, president and CEO, SUEZ Energy Resources. SUEZ Energy Resources NA currently serves commercial and industrial customers in nine states: Texas, Massachusetts, Maine, Maryland, New York, New Jersey, Pennsylvania, Illinois, Connecticut and also Washington, D.C. The company serves approximately 25,000 customer accounts, mainly with commercial and industrial customers having peak demands ranging from 50 KW to more than 200 MW, for a total contracted load of 4,500 MW.
